CALL FOR PAPERS

Scope:

The South African Journal of Geomatics (SAJG) publishes peer-reviewed original papers within the broad discipline of Geomatics (including surveying techniques, technology and applications, mine surveying, hydrographic surveying, cadastral systems, land tenure, development planning, GIS, photogrammetry and remote sensing). The journal is designed to serve as a source reference and archive of advancements in these disciplines. The focus is on papers relevant to the South African and African context, but is not restricted to these areas. This includes both technological developments as well as social adaptations appropriate to the needs of Geomatics in Africa.

The journal appears bi-annually (January/February & July/August) exclusively in an electronic format and is an open access journal (no publication fees, no subscription fees, no access fees). SAJG is published by CONSAS Conference (a non-profit organisation which aims to promote Geomatics in South Africa), with the support of the South African Geomatics Institute (SAGI) and the Geo-Information Society of South Africa (GISSA). Representatives from these organisations, together with the Editor, form the Management Board.

The South African Journal of Geomatics is approved by the South African Department of Higher Education & Training.

Submission:

At the moment the process by which papers are to be submitted is undergoing change. Please contact the [editor](#) for details of the current submission process. Papers should be original and should be no longer than ten pages - detailed author guidelines are provided on the [web page](#). Papers are reviewed by at least two referees following submission. After review, and amendment where necessary, the paper will appear as a .pdf document on the journal web page.
